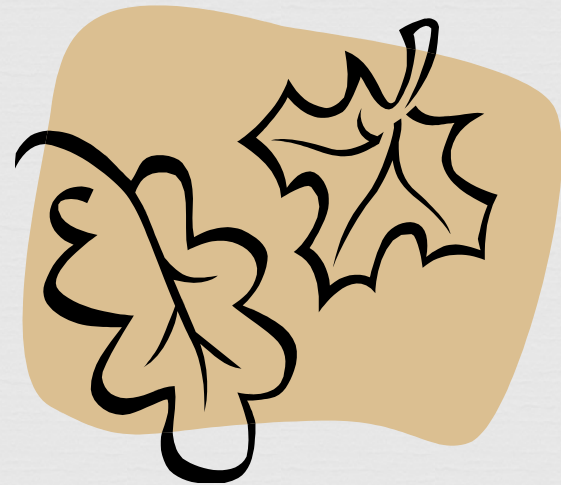

Traffic Calming Update

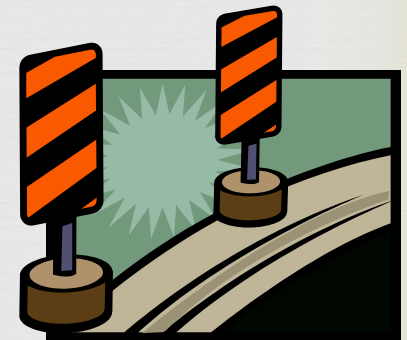


2013 Project Construction –

- ❧ Contract approved 9/22
- ❧ Projects built this fall, larger projects built Spring 2015

2014 Application Status -

- ❧ On 10/6 City Council selected 2014 Traffic Calming projects
- ❧ 20 projects from 14 Neighborhoods selected
- ❧ Total project investment: \$537,894.34
- ❧ Next Step: Neighborhoods notified of selection and projects go to preliminary design



Neighborhood Clean Up



- ❧ Surplus Funds - \$20K after scheduled fall events.
- ❧ Feedback- Solicited feedback and committee members from NC in August.
- ❧ General Recommendation: Neighborhood Council Curbside Lottery
- ❧ Deadline: All activity complete by November 1st
- ❧ Recommendation of the CA?



Community Assembly Goals



Annually the CA and Standing Committees Establish Goals to:

- ❧ review and recommend an action, policy or plan to the city council neighborhood committee, the City and any City agency, commission or board on any matter affecting the City;
- ❧ support and promote citizen participation and neighborhood enhancement;
- ❧ promote and facilitate open communication between the City and neighborhood councils and provide the primary means of communication between individual neighborhood councils;
- ❧ identify specific needs and support needed from ONS

Neighborhood Liaison Pilot



Program launched 1 year ago for a Consolidated Communications and Outreach Plan to:

- ❧ Provide consistent, reliable and comprehensive communication to and from neighborhood leaders
- ❧ Increase engagement in neighborhoods and strengthening of the neighborhoods voice in the Community and Neighborhood Services Division
- ❧ Increased access to information about programs and services

Neighborhood Liaison Pilot



The program has the goals of:

- ✧ Providing ONS staff participation on an as needed basis by the neighborhood, to include attendance by the liaison at neighborhood meetings of at least once each quarter.
- ✧ Address questions about various City activities; provide information on ONS and city programs; and follow up to connect neighborhoods with departments or agencies on concerns or issues.

Evaluate the program effectiveness at 3, 6 and 12 months. Reaching out to Neighborhood Councils in October for one on one meetings with leaders, discussing at neighborhood meetings, or surveys for input on the program.

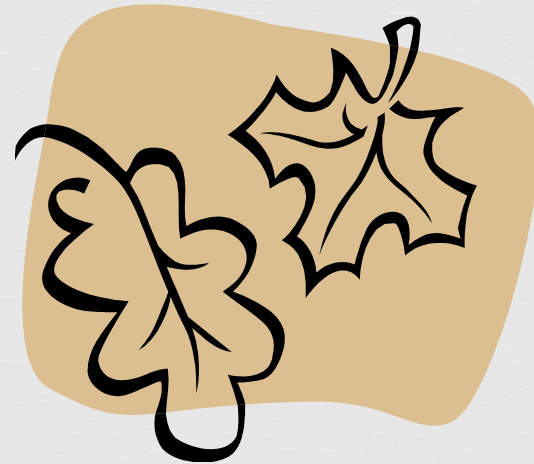
