Any member who is interested in having Neighborhoods, USA (NUSA) take a position concerning an issue of interest to neighborhoods is invited to submit a resolution.

A resolution is a written motion. The preamble consists of clauses started by the word "Whereas." The resolution states the action or position which is requested of NUSA.

Attached is a form for your use. The Bylaws and Rules Committee will review the resolution and will contact the writer for clarification or revision, if needed. It is required that the author's name, hotel and room number be filled in on the space provided on the resolution form in the event clarification is necessary.

NUSA is a 501 (c) (3) organization and is, therefore, precluded from lobbying or taking positions on political issues.

Please submit proposed resolution to the NUSA booth no later than 5:00 p.m. local time on the Friday of the conference.

NOTE: The author of the resolution must be present at the General Membership meeting to answer any questions from the Board and/or membership.
